The one-time enrolment fee of \$40 covers lifetime registration for the horse in the CHB-AD Versatility Program. Point recording forms should be submitted promptly after December 31 each year, for points to be properly allocated and considered for awards for the proper year.

Additional scoring opportunities and regulations:

Add two bonus points if horse is driven as both single and team in any combination of above listed driving activities.

Add two bonus points per additional category if shown in two or more categories in any one show (ie english and western and driving and in-hand represents four categories, and earns 3 x 2 bonus points = 6 bonus points).

** Points for non-competitive activities are eligible for valuations once per year.
